

The regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the People's Institute & Free Dispensary was held December 11, 1922, Mrs. Corbett presiding.

Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

Treasurer's report read and placed on file.

REPORT OF COMMITTEES:

Miss Prichard reported for Mrs. Gillison that the card party had netted \$380.00; (later receipts made total of \$406.00).

Mrs. Johnson reported that she had recured two board members to solicit for Community Chest funds.

Miss Prichard's statistical report read, accepted and placed on file. This showed an average of 79 patients daily in all clinics.

The dispensary operated two booths at the Public Health Exposition. Various phases of the work were shown by photographs and several clinics were held, including baby clinics and goitre clinics.

Mrs. Johnson was made chairman of a committee to supply surgical dressings for the dispensary.

Two trained nurses, one for full time and one for part time have offered their services to the dispensary.

Two hundred letters to members have been sent out requesting them to aid the Community Chest Campaign. A

letter was received from Mrs. Dalas Backe, president of the League of Women Voters, asking that a member of the People's Institute be appointed to represent this organization in a Legislative Council which is being organized by the League. Mrs. Gillison was appointed as a representative.

Mrs. Hunt Lewis was asked to take charge of booths for the sale of Red Cross Christmas sales. Mrs. Rockey, and Mrs. Wight were appointed a committee to cooperate with the Oregon Child Health Association.

It was decided to give another card party to raise funds to close the year's deficit. Mrs. Shevlin, Chairman, Mrs. Johnson, Mrs. Kerr, Mrs. Rockey, Mrs. Thompson and Mrs. Wight were appointed on the committee.
