

Minutes of Meeting

March 1928

The regular monthly meeting of the Peoples Institute and Portland Free Dispensary was held on Friday morning March 2, 1928 in the office of the Dispensary. Those present were, Mrs Rockey, presiding, Mrs Kerr, Mrs Honeyman, Mrs Gillison, Mrs Chaney, Mrs Wight ~~and~~ Mrs Devereaux, ~~Mrs Chaney~~, Mrs Gerlinger and Miss Prichard.

The minutes of the Annual meeting in February were read and approved and the Treasurer's report was read and accepted. It showed expenditures for the month of \$1735.89 and a balance on hand of \$1604.51

The Statistical report, showing a total of 1768 cases and 3843 visits for the month of January was read and accepted: Miss Prichard reporting a great increase in number of patients, the average daily being 153. The lamp treatments were over five hundred in number for the past month.

Miss Prichard reported that Dr Dillehunt, who is in the east had telegraphed requesting that the annual financial report of the Dispensary be telegraphed to him and that this was done.

It was moved by Mrs Kerr, seconded by Mrs Gillison and carried, that the minutes, and reports of the annual meeting be accepted.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
